Mathew Lynn lives and works in Blackheath. He is known mainly as a portraitist working on public and private commissions in Australia & the UK. Lynn has been a finalist many times in the Archibald prize, twice runner up, won People's choice and the Packers's prize in 2013 with his portrait of Tara Moss. His other works include landscapes and figurative work where he focuses on capturing the transitory light, atmosphere and mood often in simplified and heightened abstract forms.

John Caldwell is one of Australia's master landscape artists, with more than forty solo exhibitions, twice selected for the AGNSW Wynne prize, and has received numerous awards. The primary focus of his work is the natural landscape where there is little or no evidence of human presence. Through regular working trips in Australia and overseas he gathers the reference material that results in his finished studio work.

Kayo Yokoyama was born in Japan and emigrated to Australia in 1997. Now based at Blackheath, her work centres around the theme of home. As her confidence with her craft grows, her forms and motifs have expanded, The moon and waterfalls are recent motifs, representing nature's beauty and companionship. Kayo has exhibited at Sculpture at Scenic World for the last couple of years.
